

Timeline:

Phase I: May 2016 - December 2017

- 2015-2016: Rebuilders Cohort 6 create an action plan with the goal of providing educational resources related to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe
- Winter/Spring 2016: "Anishinaabe Engagement, Education, and Empowerment" (3E) planning grant was written and submitted by Lorna LaGue and Jill Doerfler
- May 2016: 3E planning grant awarded by the Bush Foundation
- June 2016: First two 3E meetings, focused on group members building trust, defining values, discussions of common goals, and means to achieve those goals
- July 2016: Strategic planning retreat facilitated by Indigenous
 Collaboration and group meeting to discuss/finalize the plan, new name:
 Zaagibagaang
- August 2016 December 2016: Ongoing group meetings focused on the first steps in executing the strategic plan, RFP created and circulated, Hunt+Capture selected

• Phase II: January 2017 - June 2018

- January 2017 February 2017: Group meetings, work with Hunt+Capture to create logo/design assets and video ideas/scripts.
- March 2017: Large meeting with Native Nations Institute, Hunt+Capture filmed John Morrin's presentation as well as many attendees for social media clips
- April 2017-June 2017: Ongoing group meetings, continued work with Hunt+Capture, work to build the website

- July 2017: Website and Facebook pages go live with initial content, creation of a brochure and promotional items
- August 2017 October 2018: Continued work on additional content/materials and made them available as they were ready
- August 2017 February 2018: Ongoing group meetings, informational tables and distribution of promotional items at MCT Constitutional Convention Meetings and other events

• Phase III: October 2018 - December 2019

- October 2018 January 2019: Ongoing group meetings planning for "Get Informed, Get Involved" live series
- January 2019 June 2019: 8 live sessions were held, group meetings held as needed
- June 2019 December 2019: Ongoing group meetings, created the "Get Informed – Get Involved: Constitutional Resources" booklet and pocket constitution, continued website updates.
- December 2019: Group members agree to focus on distributing the new printed materials for a few months and consider what the next steps for the group might be.
- March 2020: Global pandemic stalls efforts to distribute materials,
 Facebook account is kept active, materials remain available on the website
